- Trained, insured and caring drivers
- Ability for personal care attendants and companions to accompany client
- Friendly office and dispatch staff for scheduling appointments

*We need **VOLUNTEER DRIVERS**... to provide our services!*

- Flexible schedule - work as often or as little as you want
- No CDL (commercial driver's license) required
- Vehicles, gas, and insurance provided by Curative Connections
- Training provided via ride-along(s) with current drivers
- Minimal physical requirements (no heavy lifting or client transfers)
- Requirements: 18+ years, valid Wisconsin driver's license, good driving record and a completed volunteer application
