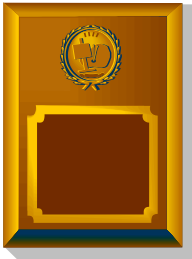

Election Changes effective for 2016

Voter Photo ID is Back for 2016: All voters **must show** an acceptable photo ID in order to vote for the 2016 February Primary, unless you are an indefinitely confined voter. More information will be included in the Annual Newsletter and online at the Town website highlighting acceptable IDs. *Acceptable Photo IDs include:* WI Driver's License*, WI Driver's License receipt, WI State ID card*, WI State ID receipt, US Passport*, Armed Forces ID card*, Accepted Student ID, Federally Recognized Tribal ID card, or Certificate of Naturalization. Listed IDs with an asterisk* must be unexpired to be considered a valid photo ID.]

Absentee Ballots:

- Absentee voting begins the third Monday before the election and ends at 5 pm the Friday before the election. **NO IN-PERSON absentee voting can take place on Saturday, Sunday or Monday before the election.**
- A photo ID will be required for IN-PERSON absentee voting and MAIL-IN absentee voting, unless you are an indefinitely confined voter.

Absentee Ballots must be in writing, include a photocopy of a valid ID, signed and dated by the elector and received by the Clerk no less than FIVE days before the scheduled election. You must be a REGISTERED VOTER to request an Absentee Ballot. Lottery / Gaming Credit on your 2014 & 2015 Property Tax Bill

Wisconsin residents should have received a tax credit (Lottery & Gaming Credit) on their 2014 property tax bill if you were a Wisconsin resident and use your dwelling as your primary residence as of January 1st. Rental properties are not eligible. The Brown County Treasurer's Office is asking that eligible property owners review their 2014 real estate tax bill to verify they received this lottery credit. Last year's average lottery credit for Brown County was \$110. If you did not receive the 2014 lottery credit, you should contact the Brown County Treasurer's Office at (920) 448-4074 and they will assist you in filing the late 2014 claim form with the Department of Revenue and assist in filing a lottery credit application for 2015 to ensure you receive this credit in 2015. The lottery credit application can be obtained online at www.revenue.wi.gov/forms/lottery/index.html.
